

## Stefano Farolfi



**Stefano Farolfi** is a senior economist at the French Agricultural Research Centre for International Development (CIRAD). He holds a PhD from the University of Padova (Italy) and a professorship in economics from the University of Montpellier I (France). He is currently a Professor at the University Eduardo Mondlane, where he is the Scientific Director of the International Center for Water Economics and Governance in Africa (IWEGA). He holds an international fellowship at the Centre for Environmental Economics and Policy in Africa (CEEPA) of the University of Pretoria, where he was residential fellow from 2002 to 2009 coordinating a number of projects on water governance and management and teaching courses of environmental economics and policy.

Dr Farolfi published numerous scientific articles on the economics of water and co-edited a 2006 Earthscan book on water governance and sustainable development. His main research interests refer to the negotiation and coordination aspects of water management and allocation.
